<b>Gregorius, Stift Engelszell, Dark Ale, Austria</b> 9.7%	11
<i>The first beer from Stift Engelszell is a dark ale at 9.7% abv, named after Abbott Gregorius Eisvogel who was at the Abbey for 25 years. Gergorius uses honey local to the monastery and a unique Alsatian wine yeast.</i>
